County	-----	Manor	-----	W	Change of Boundary indicating the point at which the character of a Boundary changes.	27
County	-----	Municipal Ward	-----	D	As above, but indicating that the space so enclosed is a Municipal Ward.	27
Parishes	-----	Urban District	-----	P	As above, but indicating that the space so enclosed is a Parish.	27
Parishes	-----	Civil Parishes	-----	P	As above, but indicating that the space so enclosed is a Civil Parish.	27

Every parcel is numbered thus: 1000 1000 1000. The area is given, and the number is in feet. The number indicating that the space so enclosed is a Municipal Ward, or Parish, or Civil Parish, is in the same reference number and area.

Altitudes indicated thus (S.M. 547) refer to Bench Marks or other points of reference.
