



Heirs and Successors the said yearly rent or sum of Nine hundred
and sixty pounds upon the respective days and in the manner
aforesaid and will during the said term pay the land tax like

and other buildings hereby demised together with all fixtures therein

fences boundary stones and posts thereto belonging being previously
furnished with or allowed to cut necessary and proper timber rough
wood thorns stakes and bushes for all such repairs And will also
once in every year in a proper manner clear out and cleanse all
the watercourses Sluices sewers and drains belonging to the said
premises and in case the said principal Secretary of State for the
War Department or his Successors shall at any time neglect or
omit to cleanse the said Ditches and Watercourses sewers and
drains as aforesaid it shall be lawful for the said James Kenneth
Howard or other the said Commissioner or Commissioners for the
time being having the management of the premises hereby demised
to direct the same to be done and to charge the expence thereof to
the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or
his successors which may be recovered as rent hereby reserved and
in arrear and will take effectual means for the safety and
preservation of all Trees and Plantations upon the demised premises
it being intended and the Secretary of State for War hereby
covenants with Her Majesty her Heirs and Successors that the said
principal Secretary of State for War and his successors shall be
responsible for and that he and they shall pay to the said
James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners
for the time being as aforesaid the value or amount of any damage
or injury which may be done or occasioned to the Trees or plantations
during the continuance of this demise either by fire or in any
other manner whatsoever except only such (if any) injury or damage
as may be done by any Servants or Agents of the said James
Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners for the
time being as apreswrd such value or amount to be from time
to time ascertained by the Deputy Surveyor for the time being of

James Kenneth Howard or such other Commissioner or Commissioners
as aforesaid and if the said repairs shall not be well and sufficiently
made good within the time expressed in any such notice as aforesaid
it shall and may be lawful to and for the said James Kenneth
Howard or such other Commissioner or Commissioners as aforesaid to direct
the same to be done by such person or persons as he or they
shall think fit to employ therein and to charge the said Principal
Secretary of State for the War Department and his successors with the
expences of such repairs the amount of which shall and may be recovered
by distress or otherwise as rent reserved and in arrear And also that he
the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department and
his successors will preserve all the fir and other planted trees saps
and saplings for the time being standing or growing upon the said
premises from bite of cattle or other Injuries and will not without the
consent in writing of the said James Kenneth Howard or other the —

Commissioner or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid cut down fell
or destroy top top or prune any of such trees species or saplings and in
case any of them being with such consent as aforesaid so cut down
destroyed or injured as aforesaid the values thereof shall be from time to
time paid by the said Principal Secretary of State for the War —
Department to the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner
or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid such value to be ascertained
by the Deputy Surveyor for the time being of Her Majesty's Alcotments
in Alce Holt Forest in the County of Southampton and the amount so
paid shall in the event of the purchase hereinafter mentioned being completed
be deemed to be a portion of the purchase money for the said lands and
hereditaments to be ascertained in manner hereinafter mentioned and in the
mean time the same amount shall be treated as a deposit in respect of
such purchase and in the event of the said purchase not being completed
shall be absolutely forfeited to Her Majesty and shall be applied in the
same manner as that in which the whole purchase money would have
been applied if the purchase had been completed and no reduction in
rent shall be made in consequence of any such payment And shall
not nor will at any time during the continuance of this demise raise
or remove any mineral substance stone clay brick or tile earth gravel
sand or soil from the said premises except materials for making
new roads or repairing existing roads in or upon the said premises
And shall not commit or suffer any wilful or voluntary waste spoil
or destruction in or upon the said demised premises or any part
thereof And also that he the said Principal Secretary of State for
the War Department and his successors will not assign or underlet the
said premises hereby demised or any part thereof without the license
and consent writing of the said James Kenneth Howard or such other
Commissioner or Commissioners as aforesaid And further that he the
said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department his successors or
agents will at his or their costs and charges procure every assignment
which may with such license as aforesaid be made of these presents
or of the premises hereby demised or any part thereof to be within
six calendar months from the date thereof enrolled in the Office of
Land Revenue Records and Settlements and a Minute or Doquet thereof
entered in the Office of the said Commissioners for the time being of
Her Majesty's Woods Forests and Land Revenues Provided and these presents
are upon this express condition Nevertheless that if the said yearly rent
of Nine hundred and sixty pounds or any part thereof or the said
additional rents hereby severally reserved or either of them or any part

of the same respectively shall be unpaid for the space of forty days next after either of the said days hereinbefore appointed for the payment of the same respectively or in case the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department his successors or assigns shall not observe and perform the several covenants agreements and conditions herein contained and which on his or their part ought to be observed and performed then and in any of the said cases it shall be lawful for Her said majesty Her Heirs and Successors or the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid on behalf of Her said majesty Her Heirs and Successors to enter into and upon and retain possession of the said hereby demised premises as fully and effectually in all respects as if these presents had never been made provided always and it is hereby agreed and declared that the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or his successors shall (subject to the approval of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury) be at liberty at any time during the continuance of this lease to purchase of the Freehold and Inheritance of the said lands and hereditaments hereby demised and also of the said excepted premises on leaving at the Office of the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid three calendar months previous notice in writing of his or their intention so to do the amount to be paid for the same to be settled by the two arbitrators or in case of their disagreement by any umpire to be chosen by them one of such Arbitrators to be appointed by the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid and the other to be appointed by the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or his successors, and in case any such notice shall be given the said Principal Secretary of State or his successors shall be and be and they are hereby bound to complete the said purchase and on payment of the amount so to be ascertained as aforesaid and any rent which may be then due as herein provided and of the expences of preparing and enrolling the conveyance he the said James Kenneth Howard or such other Commissioner or Commissioners as aforesaid will execute a proper conveyance in Duplicate of all and singular the said premises unto the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or to whom he or they may appoint such conveyance to be prepared by the Solicitor of Land Revenue in the form usually adopted in the Office of Her Majestys Woods Forests and Land Revenues for the Conveyance of Estates by the Crown and neither the said Principal Secretary of State for the War

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Department nor His successors shall require any evidence of title to the said premises; And it is hereby covenanted and declared that in case the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or his Successors shall agree to purchase the freehold and inheritance of the lands and hereditaments hereby demised such contract shall not prejudice or affect the rights of Her Majesty to recover and receive the full amount of the rent reserved by this Indenture or to enforce the covenants and powers of re-entry herein contained until the completion of the purchase and if such purchase shall be completed in the course of any current quarter then there shall be payable by him or them to the Queen's Majesty her Heirs and successors in addition to any rent then due in respect of the said premises a proportionate part of the accruing rent for the then current quarter of a year from the last quarterly day of payment up to the day on which the said purchase shall be completed; provided also And it is hereby further agreed and declared that it shall be lawful for the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioner or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid or for the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or his Successors to determine this present lease at the expiration of the first seven or fourteen years of the term hereby granted by leaving for the said Principal Secretary of State for the War Department or for the said James Kenneth Howard or other the Commissioners or Commissioners for the time being as aforesaid as the case may be at the War Office in place Mall, or at the Office of the said Commissioners, six calendar months previous notice in writing of such his or their intention And the said James Kenneth Howard as such Commissioner as aforesaid doth hereby direct that this Deed shall be deemed to be fully and sufficiently enrolled by the deposit of a Duplicate thereof in the Office of Land Revenue Records and Involments and the filing or making an entry of such deposit by the Keeper of the said Records and Involments In witness whereof the said parties to these presents of the second and third parts have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.



Dated 31st Dec: 1858 This Indenture made the thirty first day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight Between The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty of the first part The Honorable James Kenneth Howard the Commissioner of Her Majesty's Honourable Woods Forests and Land Revenues to whom the management and — to — direction of certain of the Woods Forests and Land Revenues of the Crown Crawshay Colliery including amongst other parts thereof the Royal Forest of Dean with & Bennett the duties and powers appertaining thereto have been assigned by order under the hands of the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury of the Lease of 4 pieces second part and Henry Crawshay of Oddlands Park near of Waste Land in Newnham in the Forest of Dean and County of Gloucester Esquire Dean Forest in Stephen Allaway of Courtsfield in the County of Hereford Esquire connection with the and Timothy Bennett of Mitcheldean in the said County Foxes Bridge Colliery Gentleman of the third part Whereas by an Act of Parliament made and passed in the first and second years of Her present Majesty Item 5 yrs Rent £1. cap. 143 intituled "An Act for regulating the opening and working of Mines and Quarries in the Forest of Dean and Hundred of St Briavels in the County of Gloucester" It was by the twenty fifth section of the said act enacted that it should be lawful for the Commissioners for the time being of Her Majesty's Woods Forests Land Revenues Works and Buildings from time to time to grant leases for terms not exceeding Thirty one years to any free miner or other person entitled to a Gale or Mining work of any part of the unenclosed waste land of the said Forest for the purpose of erecting thereon any House Building or Machinery for the more convenient working any mine or for any purpose connected with any mine or work so as there should not be included more than one and a half acres of land in any such lease and every such lease should be granted upon such conditions and subject to such covenants or restrictions as might appear to the said Commissioners to be fit or proper and every such lease should within three calendar months from the granting thereof be enrolled in the Office of Land Revenue Records and Inventments and a Minute or Deed thereof entered in the Office of Woods Forests Land Revenues Works and Buildings And whereas the said Henry Crawshay Stephen Allaway and Timothy Bennett are the Registered Owners of a certain Gale or Colliery called or known as the Foxes Bridge Colliery in the said Forest of Dean and as such Registered Owners lately applied to the said James Kenneth Howard as such Commissioner as aforesaid (in whom the powers given to the






