This Indenture made the thirtieth day of August One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight Between The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty of the first part The Honorable James Kenneth Howard the Commissioner of Her Majesty's Woods Forests and Land Revenues to whom the management and direction of the Royal Forest of Dean with the duties and powers appertaining thereto have been duly assigned under the Act Fourteenth and Fifteenth Victoria Chapter 112 Section 5 of the second part and Edmund Morgan of Moseley Green in the Township of West Dean in the County of Gloucester Colliery Proprietor George Morris Morse of Yorkley in the Township of West Dean aforesaid and Frederic Morse of the said last mentioned place of the third part Whereby by an Indenture of Lease bearing date the twenty fourth day of February One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and made between The Queen's Majesty of the first part the said James Kenneth Howard as such Commissioner as aforesaid of the second part and the said Edmund Morgan of the third part the premises hereinafter described and hereby intended to be demised were demised unto the said Edmund Morgan as the Registered Owner of a certain Colliery called the Wellington Colliery his executor administrators and assigns for the term of Thirty one years from the twenty fifth day of December One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven (determinable as therein mentioned) at and under the yearly rent of Three pounds and subject to the several covenants provisions and conditions in the said Indenture of Lease contained. 



Provided lastly that if the said yearly rent of One pound hereby reserved or any part thereof shall be unpaid for the space of forty days next after either of the days hereinbefore appointed for payment thereof or in case the said John and Thomas Powell their executors administrators or assigns and every of them shall not well and effectually perform and keep all and every the covenants and conditions herein contained and on their parts to be observed and performed then in any such case the License hereby granted shall absolutely cease and be void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof notwithstanding and the said James Kenneth Howard as such Commissioner as aforesaid doth hereby direct that this Deed shall be deemed to be fully and sufficiently enrolled by the deposit of a Duplicate thereof in the Office of Land Revenue Records and Enrolments and the filing or making an entry of such deposit by the Keeper of the said Records and Enrolments.
