The Agreement made and entered into this
thirty first day of January One thousand eight hundred and
seventy four Between The Queen's Most Excellent
Majesty of the first part The Honourable James
Kenneth Howard the Commissioner of Her Majesty's
Woods Forests and Land Revenues to whom the management and
direction of (with other parts of the Land Revenues of the Crown)
the Royal Forest of Dean in the County of Gloucester with
the duties and powers appertaining thereto have been duly
assigned under the Act 11th and 15th Victoria Chap 42 of
the second part and Tom Brown Junior of the
third part.

The said James Kenneth Howard as such Commissioner as aforesaid
hereby agrees to let to the said Tom Brown Junior who hereby agrees to

Whereas the "Littledean Woodside Coal Company Limited" carrying on business in the Forest of Dean and County of Gloucester now hold a Gale of Coal within the Forest of Dean and Hundred of St Briavels called the Haywood Colliery and have requested Thomas Forster Brown the Deputy Surveyor of the said Forest to grant to them the said Littledean Woodside Coal Company the license or right to make and form the Tramway as aforesaid and to leave the Company Limited use and enjoyment thereof as aforesaid and the General Warrant to make a tramroad James Kenneth Howard the Commissioner of Her Majesty's Woods Forests and Land Revenues to whom the management and connection with direction of the Royal Forests with the duties and power appertaining thereto have been assigned under the hands of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hath signified his consent by a writing under his hand that such license should be granted.

Now therefore I the said Thomas Forster Brown as such Deputy Surveyor as aforesaid in pursuance of all powers vested in me in this behalf and with such consent as aforesaid do grant unto the said Littledean Woodside Coal Company Limited and all other persons or person for the time being Owners or Owner of the said Haywood Colliery a license to make and form a tramroad of 12 feet in width across the open Forest commencing at a point near the Haywood pit and marked A upon the plan drawn in the margin of these presents and extending in a northerly direction through the points marked B and C as shown by a red line upon the said plan and from the said point B in a southerly direction through points marked D. F and G to a point marked H in the Great Western Railway save and except the portion between the point D and E occupied by the Turnpike road from Littledean to Nailbridge and between the points marked F and G which tract is held under lease by Mr Peter Costance and is colored yellow upon the said plan for the purpose of carrying on the work or works opened or to be opened by virtue of the said Gale and to use and occupy the same for the purpose aforesaid but for no other purpose whatsoever To hold the said license unto the said Littledean Woodside Coal Company and such other person or persons as aforesaid for the term of Twenty one years from the 1st day of January 1874 subject to the rules and regulations set forth in the Second Schedule to the Award.







The Honourable Sir K Howard a Commissioner of Her

The Severn &
Wye Railway
and Canal Company hereinafter
called the Company of the third part Whereas the Company were
empowered by an Act of the forty ninth George 3rd Chapter 159
as amended by an Act of the fiftieth George 3rd Cap. 215 to construct
a line of Tramway in the Forest of Dean and were bound at their
expense to fence in the said Tramway so far as it extended through
the land belonging to Her majesty and to maintain the fences in good
repair And whereas by an Agreement dated on or about the
fifteenth day of January One thousand eight hundred and eleven
made between the Commissioners appointed under and by virtue of
an Act of the fiftieth George the Third Chapter 65 intituled an Act
for uniting the Offices of the Surveyor General of the Land Revenues
of the Crown and Surveyor General of His Majestys Woods Forests
Parks and Chases and the Company It was agreed that the said
Commissioners should cause the quantity of fencing to be made and
maintained which the Company were bound to make and maintain
