

The Deputy Surveyor informs Mr Stoward that you are desirous of using a ditch in the Crown waste between the points A & B on the enclosed tracing for the purpose of draining the rain water from the roofs of some cottages built on the land N° 2614 on the tracing, to lay pipes therein, to cover in the ditch and to have access to your land over it from the Crown waste, and I am to inform you that he is willing to grant you permission during pleasure to use the ditch, and to have the desired access upon the following conditions, viz:

1. An acknowledgement of 1/- per annum is to be paid to the Deputy Surveyor hereafter in advance on the 5<sup>th</sup> July in each year during the continuance of this permission payment of a similar sum being made upon the acceptance of these terms.






