This Indenture made the fifteenth day of February 1901
 Between The Most Noble Henry Adelbert Wellington Fitzroy
 Ninth Duke of Beaufort (hereinafter referred to as the Duke)
 of the first part The Most Noble Louise Emily Duchess of
 Beaufort (hereinafter referred to as the Duchess) of the second part
 Edward Stafford Howard Esquire B.D. one of the Commissioners
 of His Majesty's Woods Forests and Land Revenues of the third part
 and The King's Most Excellent Majesty of the fourth part
 Whereas the Duke is seized of or otherwise well entitled to the manors
 lordships advowsons farms lands messuages tenements and heredit-
 aments hereinafter described and intended to be hereby conveyed
 for an estate of inheritance in fee simple except where a less estate
 in any hereditaments is expressed to be conveyed and subject only
 to certain jointure rent charges collaterally secured to the Duchess on
 the Monmouthshire Estates of the Duke on their marriage in the year
 1895 and otherwise subject as hereinafter expressed And whereas
 the said Edward Stafford Howard in exercise of the powers of the Acts
 10th George the Fourth Chapter 50 and 11th and 15th Victoria Chapter
 42 and with the authority of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's
 Treasury signified by their Warrant bearing date the twenty first day
 of September 1900 has contracted with the Duke for the purchase on
 behalf of His Majesty of the said manors lordships advowsons farms
 lands messuages and hereditaments and the fee simple and
 inheritance thereof free from all incumbrances at the price of
 £190,170 And whereas the Duchess has agreed for the purpose of
 releasing her said jointure rent charges to join in these Presents in
 manner hereinafter expressed Now this indenture witnesseth
 that in pursuance of and for effectuating the said sale and in
 consideration of the sum of £190,170 on or before the execution of
 these Presents paid by the said Edward Stafford Howard on behalf
 of the King's Majesty to the Duke (of which sum of £190,170 the Duke
 hereby acknowledges the receipt) the Duke as Beneficial Owner hereby
 conveys and the Duchess as Mortgagee hereby conveys and releases
 unto the King's Majesty All and singular the manors and
 lordships or reputed manors lordships (except advowsons and rights
 of patronage) farms lands messuages and hereditaments respectively
 known as "The Raglan Estate" containing 3,168 ^a 2 ^r 34 ^p or
 thereabouts and "The Lintern Estate" containing 5,333 ^a 2 ^r 7 ^p or
 thereabouts both situate in the County of Monmouth the particulars

of which are set out in Parts 1 and 2 of the First Schedule to these Presents and which premises are for the purpose of reference shown on the Ordnance (6 inch) Maps annexed hereto and thereon respectively coloured red and blue and are more particularly delineated and described on ten (25 inch) Ordnance Maps of "The Haglan Estate" marked $\frac{R}{1}$ to $\frac{R}{10}$ inclusive and on twenty one (25 inch) Ordnance Maps of "The Tintern Estate" marked $\frac{T}{1}$ to $\frac{T}{21}$ inclusive which Maps have been signed by Henry William Bruton on behalf of His Majesty and by Henry Jonas on behalf of the Duke and are deposited in the Office in London of His Majesty's Commissioners of Woods. And all the estate and interest of the Duke in the Ferry over the River Wye at Tintern and the Ferry Boat belonging thereto and all and all manner of tithes of corn grain or hay and all other tithes whatsoever both great and small and all moduses and rent charges in lieu or commutation of tithes (if any) issuing out of or charged upon any part of the premises and belonging to the Duke Together with the exclusive right of fishing from the lands hereby conveyed on the right bank with a rod in half of that part of the River Wye which runs between the Southern limit of the Lower Wyndcliff Wood and the Northern limit of the lands at Graigwood shown on the Maps aforesaid Together with all rights (if any) of the Duke to a supply of water by pipes to Fox Farm and Moss Cottage described in the Second Part of the said First Schedule and on Map $\frac{T}{9}$ in the Parishes of Chapel Hill and St. Arvans from a spring on the Wyndcliff in a field belonging to Henry Clay Esquire and numbered 28 on Map $\frac{T}{9}$. Together with the perpetual right so far as the Duke can grant the same for the King's Majesty His Heirs Successors and Assigns for ever to use the stream of water passing through the brook bounding the premises 10.121 on Map $\frac{T}{4}$ near Clearwater. Will such user nevertheless in no way to limit interfere with or affect prejudicially the right of user of such stream of water by Richard Barnett his heirs or assigns or the occupiers or occupier of the future owners or owners for the time being of certain mills called or known by the name of Upper and Lower Tonside Mills Except and always reserving unto the Duke his heirs assigns and successors in title. Duke has in all the bed and soil of the River Wye and all rights of fishery in the waters of the said River other than the right of rod fishing hereby conveyed whether now vested in the Duke as riparian owner or under any brown charter or grant or otherwise and all incidental rights conferred by any such charter or grant except as aforesaid together with full and free liberty right and power for the Duke his heirs assigns and successors in title owners or owners for the time being of the said bed soil and fishery rights and his and their fishermen and servants with or without nets and fishing gear to land and enter upon any part of the soil adjoining the water of the said river and lying within 50 yards of the edge of the water for any purpose connected with the said fishery rights. And except and always reserving to the Duke his heirs and assigns and successors in title and his and their lessees and tenants owners or occupiers for the time being of the lands known as Slandenny Bottom delineated in the Map ^R a full and free right of way to pass and repass for all purposes with or without horses carts or other vehicles and cattle sheep or other animals over and across the field No 354 on the Map ^R and over the bridge spanning the small stream to the High Road leading from Slandenny to Bonmouth and adjoining Slandenny Railway Station in the direction shewn upon that Map whereon the same is marked "right of way" And except and always reserving to the Duke his heirs and assigns and successors in title owners or occupiers of the site of Raglan Castle full and free right of way over the field No 1148 on the Map ^R for all purposes in connection with repairing the Eastern Gate marked on the said Map "White Gate" on the East side of the Castle. of any particular land by which any rent mentioned in the said First Schedule was reserved or whether the occupier claim to be entitled to the fee simple and whether subject to a quit rent or fee farm rent or rentcharge or not and as to all the premises subject to all existing leases and tenancies including the leases of sporting rights specified in the Second Schedule hereto and subject to the right of the owners and occupiers from time to time of "The Rose & Crown" Inn at Lintern and of Ashweir House to be supplied with water for all needs as at present supplied by pipes from a tank on adjoining land part of the Lintern Estate and also subject to and with the benefit of an easement of water granted on lease at a nominal rent of Five shillings a year to Colonel Rooke by an Indenture dated the ninth day of May 1900 and also subject to a covenant entered into by the Duke (by an Indenture of conveyance dated the ~~twentieth~~ twentieth day of March 1899) with Colonel Percival Scrope Warling to convey to him when no longer wanted for use and upon the terms in the said Indenture mentioned the site of the Railway and Tramway leading from the Wye Valley Railway to the Abbey Lintern Wire Works so far as such Railway intersected the lands by the said Indenture conveyed to the said Percival Scrope Warling and also the bridge carrying the said Railway or Tramway over the River Wye. And the Duke for himself his heirs executors and administrators hereby covenants with the King's Majesty His Heirs and Successors at all times hereafter to keep him and them effectually indemnified from and against all duties which have or may become payable or be claimed in respect of the hereditaments hereby conveyed upon the death of Henry Charles Fitzroy the Eighth and late Duke of Beaufort or the death of Georgiana Charlotte Dowager Duchess of Beaufort and the Duchess or either or any of them and from and against all claims demands actions proceedings costs and expenses whatsoever for and in respect of the same or any part thereof respectively, and further that the Duke his heirs and assigns and successors in title owners of Haglan Castle will forthwith if required by the said Edward Stafford Howard plant and for ever maintain on the strip of land ~~being~~ part of the land

No. 141 on the Map $\frac{R}{3}$ and adjoining the ground on which stand the Ruins of Baglan Castle and in the position shown by the red dotted line on the said Map a quickset hedge so as to fence off the said strip of land (which is not hereby conveyed) from the rest of the land No. 141 and so that such strip of land may afford a means of access to the castle or the walls thereof by the Duke his heirs and assigns and successors in title And the Duke hereby acknowledges the right of the Kings Majesty His Heirs Successors and Assigns to production of and to delivery of copies of the documents specified in the Third Schedule hereunder written which are retained by the Duke and hereby undertakes for the safe custody thereof and covenants with the Kings Majesty that all the obligations and liabilities imposed by Law in respect of the said documents shall be observed and performed not only at the request in writing of His Majesty or of any person claiming through or under him but also at the request in writing of a Commissioner for the time being of His Majesty's Woods Forests and Land Revenues or of the Law Officers of the Crown. And the said Edward Stafford Howard doth hereby direct that this Deed shall be deemed to be fully and sufficiently enrolled by the deposit of a duplicate thereof in the Office of Land Revenue Records and Inrolments and the filing or making an entry of such deposit by the Keeper of the said Records and Inrolments In witness whereof the said parties to these Presents of the first second and third parts have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
