1. An acknowledgment of £2 2 · 0 is to be paid to the Deputy Surveyor in advance on the 10th October in each future year, the first payment in respect of the year to the 10th October 1903 to be made on the acceptance of this offer.
2. A fence is to be erected round the land to the satisfaction of the Deputy Surveyor.
3. The shed is to be erected according to the bylaws of the district, if any exist, and the corrugated iron roof is to be painted in imitation of Broseley tiles.
4. The glazed drain pipe which empties into the middle of the roadway is to be carried a little further down as shown by the blue line on the enclosed tracing.
5. The bit of open Forest land on the west side of the proposed enclosure is to be levelled and made tidy.
6. In the event of this permission being determined the shed and fence are to be removed and the ground restored to the satisfaction of the Deputy Surveyor.


