3. This permission will be liable to be determined by the Commissioners of Woods at any time by 21 days notice which may be given by registered letter addressed to you at your then address.
4. Whenever the permission is terminated the fence will have to be removed and the ground restored to its original state to the satisfaction of the Deputy Surveyor.
