

Department and which, shortly stated,
consist of (1) alteration of line of boundary
of the Stag Inn (2) construction of staircase
entrance to your cellars, of two open gratings or ventilators
and (3) of two inspection chambers or manholes to be
placed on Crown property.

In reply to the application of your architects I am
to state as follows:-

As regards No. 1. Mr. Howard has no objection to offer
to the rectification of the line of boundary on the south
side and south-east corner between the Crown soil
in the street and the private property as shown on the
tracing which accompanied your architects' letter of the
8th inst to this Department - the proposed new line of
frontage being edged brown, the existing line of
frontage being shown by green chain lines thereon.

As regards No. 2. Mr. Howard is willing to give
you permission to construct and during the pleasure
of this Department to maintain two cellar flaps or doors
on the east side of the Stag Inn as shown by blue colour
on the said tracing and two open gratings or
ventilators which it is intended to place on Crown
property on the south side as shown on said tracing
upon the terms and conditions following, viz: -

1. You are to construct the cellar doors and gratings of such strength as will support any reasonable traffic and before commencing the works to submit details of their construction but this is not to relieve you from the responsibility for the adequacy of the protection provided and in case of the coverings proving to be insufficient you are to be responsible for any damage that may arise to persons or property.
2. An acknowledgment of 10/- per annum is to be paid to the Hon. G.W. Farselles, Deputy Surveyor of the New Forest, King's House Lyndhurst, in advance on the 10th October in each future year during the continuance of this permission, the first payment in respect of the year to 10th October 1907 to be made on the acceptance of this offer.
