Whereas by a Grant of a Gale dated the twenty seventh day of June One thousand eight hundred and forty three under the respective hands of Edward Wachen and John Atkinson the then Deputy Gavers of the Forest of Dean "a tract of coal situate near Moseley Green and under Oaken Hill Enclosure on a line with the Independent level "in the Starkey Rockey and Oaken Hill Delf Veins "and bounded as follows that is to say:- On the "North East by the Moseley Green New Engine Colliery "on the South West by the large Downthrow Fault "on the deep side by levels to be driven from points "in each vein perpendicularly under the Old "Independent level and on the land or rise side as "to the Rockey and Starkey Veins by the line of "Newmanshopshire level in these veins and as to "the Oaken Hill Delf by the line of land workings of "Moseley Green New Engine Colliery Except that "against the Newmanshopshire Colliery a barrier "of coal twenty yards in width shall be left to "be called Moseley Green New Engine No. 2 "was granted in equal parts to Henry Keath of Whitecroft and William Tear of Bream in the said Forest of Dean at the rent and royalty reserved by and on the conditions contained and referred to in such grant And whereas by divers transfers and other acts in the law and events the said Gale is now vested in Thomas Johnson of Prescott Street, Wigan in the County of Lancaster Engineer And whereas the said Thomas Johnson has not worked and carried on the said Gale in a fair orderly and workmanlike manner in accordance with Rule 9 of the Second Schedule to the Award as to Coal Mines of the Dean Forest Mining Commissioners made pursuant to the Act of Parliament 1st and 2nd Victoria Chapter 43 but has desisted from working the said Gale for a continuous space exceeding five years after the vein of coal had been gained whereby or in

consequence whereof the said Gale is become liable to forfeiture. Now I the undersigned Edward Stafford Howard the Commissioner of Woods having the management and direction of the said Forest of Dean and being the Gauceller thereof Do hereby declare that the hereinbefore recited Grant of the twenty seventh day of June One thousand eight hundred and forty three is become forfeited and void.
