

This Indenture made the eighth day of April One thousand nine hundred and thirteen Between The King's Most Excellent Majesty of the first part The Right Honorable Walter Runciman M.P. one of the Commissioners of Woods on behalf of His Majesty acting in exercise of the powers of the Crown Lands Acts 1829 to 1906 (hereinafter referred to as "the Commissioner") of the second part and John Brain and Tom Parker both of Drybrook Ernest William Gibbs, Michael Meek and John Roberts all of Plumpton Mitcheldean Thomas Taylor of Bailey Lane and Francis John Matthews and Thomas Matthews both of Plumpton aforesaid William John Smeeth of Drybrook aforesaid Minister all in the County of Gloucester The Trustees for the United Methodist Church at Plumpton Hill and hereinafter referred to as "the Trustees" of the third part Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Six pounds four shillings paid by the Trustees out of monies held by them for the benefit of the United Methodist Church to the Commissioner before the sealing and delivery of these presents of which sum the Commissioner doth hereby acknowledge the receipt the Commissioner as such Commissioner as aforesaid Doth by these presents grant unto the Trustees All that piece or parcel of land containing four perches and one half of another perch or thereabouts situate at Plumpton Hill in the County of Gloucester bounded on all sides by open Forest and measuring on the north and south sides sixty one links and on the east and west sides forty six links which said land and premises intended to be hereby granted are delineated and coloured red on the plan drawn on these presents Save and except out of this grant all mines minerals stone and other substrata whether of a metallic or of any other nature within under or upon the said land and premises with full power from time to time and at all times for ever hereafter to enter upon search for work use raise carry away and enjoy the same as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if this grant had not been made And also save and except full power from time to time and at all times hereafter to search for work draw use raise carry away and enjoy any other mines minerals stone or substrata belonging to His Majesty and lying beyond the limits of the land and premises hereby granted through or over the same as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if this grant had not been made To hold the said premises hereby conveyed (subject nevertheless to all the rights powers and privileges of all present and





Parcament to Section 1 of the Dean Forest Act 1906 it is hereby agreed by The Right Honourable Walter
Punciman, M.P. EDWARD STAFFORD HOWARD,
a Commissioner of His Majesty's Woods and the Verderers of the Forest of Dean, with the consent of the Treasury, that the parcel of land, waste of the Forest, coloured red on this Plan shall henceforth be freed from the rights of Common to which it is now subject, and that by way of exchange the parcel of land, now freehold of the Crown, coloured blue on this Plan shall henceforth be made part of the said waste of the Forest of Dean and be subject to the like rights of Common.
